Once again, congratulations on your acceptance into the 2026 Music for All National Festival Honor Ensembles. It is quite an honor and an experience that we hope you will treasure for years to come.

Below you will find updates on important information pertaining to the festival, as well as information needed to make your monthly payment. It is crucial to read through this entire email, even if you have previously participated in the Honor Ensembles.

MONTHLY PAYMENT

50% of your final balance on your account is due **February 1, 2026**. This can be paid online, or by mailing a check to our office, with the student's name clearly in the memo line.

FAMILY INFORMATION: HOTEL, TICKETS, BANQUET

Students and Family members may NOT share a room. All students are to be housed with other Honor Ensemble students, as a quad package or a double package, as indicated on your initial registration, and listed above. No single rooms will be offered for students.

Families are encouraged to purchase a Friends and Family Package, which will follow the Honor Ensemble schedule for meals and activities, including concert tickets and the Honor Ensemble banquet. Transportation to and around Indianapolis is the responsibility of the package holder.

Friends and Family package holders will be housed in the Marriott Complex in Downtown Indianapolis. This is the same hotel complex as the honor ensemble students, although the same hotel placement cannot be guaranteed.

Tickets to the Honor Band of America and Jazz Band of America concert will be sold through TicketMaster beginning Friday, February 6, 2026.

NOTE: *Honor ensemble members and Family and Friends package holders DO NOT need tickets. You only need to purchase tickets if you are a Hotel Only, or a la carte.*

HONOR ENSEMBLE MUSIC – Chair Placement

As part of the Jazz Band of America, all wind players will submit a virtual homework assignment. Rehearsal time in Indianapolis is limited, so this homework assignment will allow our faculty to see where the students are in their at-home practices, and help us plan for the best use of rehearsal time. We ask that you read through the steps below so we can distribute music for you to begin practicing.

1. All students have been given a complementary MusicFirst log in.

If you have not already done so, we encourage you to book your travel as soon as possible. As a reminder, all Honor Ensemble members must arrive to the hotel in Indianapolis and check in with Music for All Staff on Wednesday, March 12 by 1:00 p.m. You are able to leave Indianapolis after 11:00 pm at the conclusion of the Honor Ensemble Concerts on Saturday, March 15, however ALL housing packages include housing on Saturday night, and an early departure will not affect your package price. If you are flying, the earliest option to fly home is Sunday, March 16.
